Principal's Comment Nga Korero o te Tumuaki



Last Friday we celebrated World Teachers' Day at Allenton School. This was an opportunity to acknowledge the work that our teachers do for our children and what they do to support each other as part of a wider team. They were treated to a scrumptious morning tea by our support staff too! This past Wednesday the staff also celebrated Tumeke Tumuaki Day, a recent initiative where schools throughout New Zealand recognise and acknowledge the work that their principals do. How fortunate we all are to be in a place of work where the staff are so supportive of each other!

Last Tuesday we had a mihi whakatau to welcome children and their families who have started at Allenton over the past term. It was great to be able to recognise our new students and their whānau in this way. Our kapa haka group led the school with waiata and then parents and staff met for afternoon tea to finish the occasion. Many thanks to everyone involved in our mihi whakatau.



Staff have noted that there are parents and caregivers using the staff car parks as a drop off point or a parking space at either end of the school day. Please understand that these car parks are for staff use and also families who hold a mobility permit. I have also noticed car owners parking over the yellow lines while dropping and collecting students, particularly around the pedestrian crossings. I respectfully ask that parents and caregivers are mindful of this and park outside of the car parks and away from the yellow lines. The safety of children entering and exiting the school is paramount.

New parents to Allenton School may not be aware that our school is part of the Ministry of Education School Donations scheme. This scheme is to alleviate financial pressure on families. It is open to eligible schools who meet certain community-referenced criteria on the proviso that we as a school won't ask for donations from parents unless it is for activities like camps or ski trips.


