Our mihi whakatau was held last Wednesday to welcome our new students and their whānau to Allenton School. There were a lot of them, with some of the group starting in Term 4 last year after the previous mihi whakatau was held. Many thanks to all families who were able to support their children at this event. It was great to be able to have older siblings supporting their younger brothers and sisters too. We do a mihi whakatau each term, normally around three weeks into the term.

At various times I get to supervise the road patrol monitors. This is mostly very enjoyable greeting and farewelling children and their family members as they enter or leave school and talking to the patrol monitors. From time to time I have noticed that the yellow lines adjacent to the crossing are used as parking spaces by drivers for a convenient, quick and easy drop off. As drivers, we all know that yellow lines can't be used as a parking space, even if it is for a quick drop off. Please take the time to park legally further away from the crossings as this makes the crossing area much safer. Your assistance in this aspect of safety is much appreciated.

The entire school has been doing a "6C Launch" these first weeks back at school. This is to remind the children of each of our 6 global competencies as well as have some fun using them.

The programme was:

Week 2 - 1 day this week for the 3 C's we are not focussing on specifically in 2024-Creativity, Citizenship and Collaboration

Then 1 day each week on the focus C's in 2024

Week 3- Communication / Whakawhitiwhiti korero

Communicating effectively with a variety of styles, modes, and tools (including digital tools), tailored for a range of audiences.

Week 4- Character / Mana āhuatanga

Learning to deep learn, armed with the essential character traits of grit, tenacity, perseverance, resilience; and the ability to make learning an integral part of living.

Week 5- Critical Thinking / Kirirarautanga

Critically evaluating information and arguments, seeing patterns and connections, constructing meaningful knowledge, and applying it in the real world.

- 5. Click the **Start your review** button at the top right-hand corner of the page.
- 6. Select the reviewer type.
- 7. Enter your name (optional).
- 8. Follow the prompts to show that you've read the topic and enter your feedback if you'd like to comment.
- 9. Agree to the privacy statement and click "Submit review".




