Principal's Comment Nga Korero o te Tumuaki



Ka nui te mihi ki a koutou - greetings to you all

Our new accessible playground was completed two weeks ago and is getting plenty of use, both during break times and after school. We are grateful to the Lotteries Grants Board for their tremendous funding support for this project. It looks amazing and is bringing lots of

fun and joy for our tamariki! We anticipate having an official opening in the middle of next term.



Cohort entry from the start of 2027

Over the past two terms, we have been investigating the possibility of cohort entry for new entrant children from the start of 2027. This has involved giving early childhood centres and parents of prospective and recently started children the opportunity to be involved in the consultation process. Cohort entry is where children start school for the first time on set dates through the year, rather than on or after their fifth birthday. There are eight set dates throughout the year - the start of each term, or at a midpoint in the term. Other than the first day of the school year, the dates are determined by the Ministry of Education. Once a child turns five, parents can start them on one of the dates following their fifth birthday.

Following consultation, the School Board has elected to proceed with Cohort Entry from 2027.

There is evidence that starting school alongside other children helps them build relationships and supports a smoother entry to school life. We also feel that Cohort Entry will allow for better management of the start date, with children starting in groups, rather than individually throughout the year as can be the case now. I have added the Cohort Entry start dates for 2027 later in this newsletter. More information will be shared at the New Entrant Welcome Wednesday information morning in early November, but if parents have any queries about Cohort Entry in the meantime, please feel free to see either myself or Julie Tayles - the Team Leader of the Junior Area.

If you have a child who is starting at Allenton in 2027 as a New Entrant, or you know of someone who has a child in this situation, then please ensure that they are enrolled by the end of term 3 - **Friday 25 September**. It is important for our planning that we know who will be enrolling throughout the year, as this enables us to determine when classes will start. This is particularly important with Cohort Entry as noted above. It is also important to remember that we have an enrolment zone and that parts of Allenton that were in our zone several years ago, are no longer zoned for our school. Please contact the school office for details about this if you are unsure.

We have previously posted information on Hero and Facebook about the **PTA Fun Run** on Tuesday 22 September. This is being organised by our dedicated PTA, who are raising funds to update our sports uniforms. Please see the flyer later in the newsletter for more information, or refer to the recent Hero / Facebook posts. Currently Kowhai House is leading the house challenge and just over \$3,400 has been raised. Keep up the great work over the next week and a bit!

This past week we have hosted the **Life Education** caravan at school. Classes have been visiting the caravan, and of course, the adored Harold, to learn about key aspects of being healthy. Harold made a surprise visit to Allenton today, and attracted a crowd of supporters along the way.

Next week will be a busy week for a number of groups across our school. Year 6 students are heading off to camp at Woodend from Monday to Wednesday. On Thursday we have hockey, rugby and netball teams representing Allenton and Mid Canterbury at the Canterbury Primary Schools Winter Tournament. On Friday we have just over 100 middle and senior kapa haka students taking part in a Te Wiki o te Māori (Māori Language Week) ceremony at Ashburton College. Some of our Year 6 students are involved in all of these events! I wish everyone involved - players, coaches, parents, and tutors, all the best for the week ahead.



Next week I am at the International Confederation of Principals conference, an event that draws in around 1,500 delegates from New Zealand and around the world. This year Auckland is hosting the conference. Chris Miller will be Acting Principal for the time that I am away.
